As we approach 70 years of serving people with intellectual and developmental disabilities including autism, Lifeworks always reflects on our roots, on what is at the heart and soul of our agency. Families are the essential lifeblood of our agency — we were founded by 10 wonderful families in Walpole in 1954, our Board composed of all families, hired our first staff in the early 1970s and opened our first programs. Those families signed personal guarantees to help get our first homes and day programs off the ground.

This inspiration led to the development of our Family Support Program which provides staffing, training, and financial support to over 450 families in our region of service. The spirit of leadership and camaraderie led families to partner with our agency and form one of the first Autism Support Centers in the state, a center that now serves more than 1,100 people and their families.

Tonight, we recognize the wonderful accomplishments of the people we serve and the important and invaluable role of our staff in making these successes and opportunities happen. We thank you for supporting our event, hope you have a wonderful evening, and thank you for your contributions to making the evening an enormous success.

Heather Hegedus Event Emcee



Emmy award-winning journalist Heather Hegedus will serve as the emcee for the Celebration. Heather recently joined Fidelity Investments as editor/on-air anchor for Viewpoints and Market Sense. Born and raised in Boston, for the past 23 years, she has reported on business, health/science, crime/the legal system, the environment, education, and DEI. She moved six times in nine years for anchor and reporter jobs in Hartford, New York, and D.C. Prior to Fidelity, Heather served as the weekday morning anchor of a live, daily 6 ½ hour morning show on Boston 25 News, the Fox affiliate, where she spent the bulk of her career. Highlights include an Emmy Award for her reporting on the opioid epidemic, and Emmy nomination for a documentary about early intervention waitlists and research underway to gain a greater understanding of autism. This spring, her work covering the Boston Marathon bombing will be featured in a Smithsonian Channel documentary.

Heather graduated Magna Cum Laude from Georgetown University and from Columbia University's Graduate School of Journalism. Having a family member with autism and intellectual disability, Heather is passionate about helping special needs families advocate for themselves. She serves on the President's Council of the New England Center for Children and frequently volunteers to emcee fundraising events for organizations like Lifeworks.
