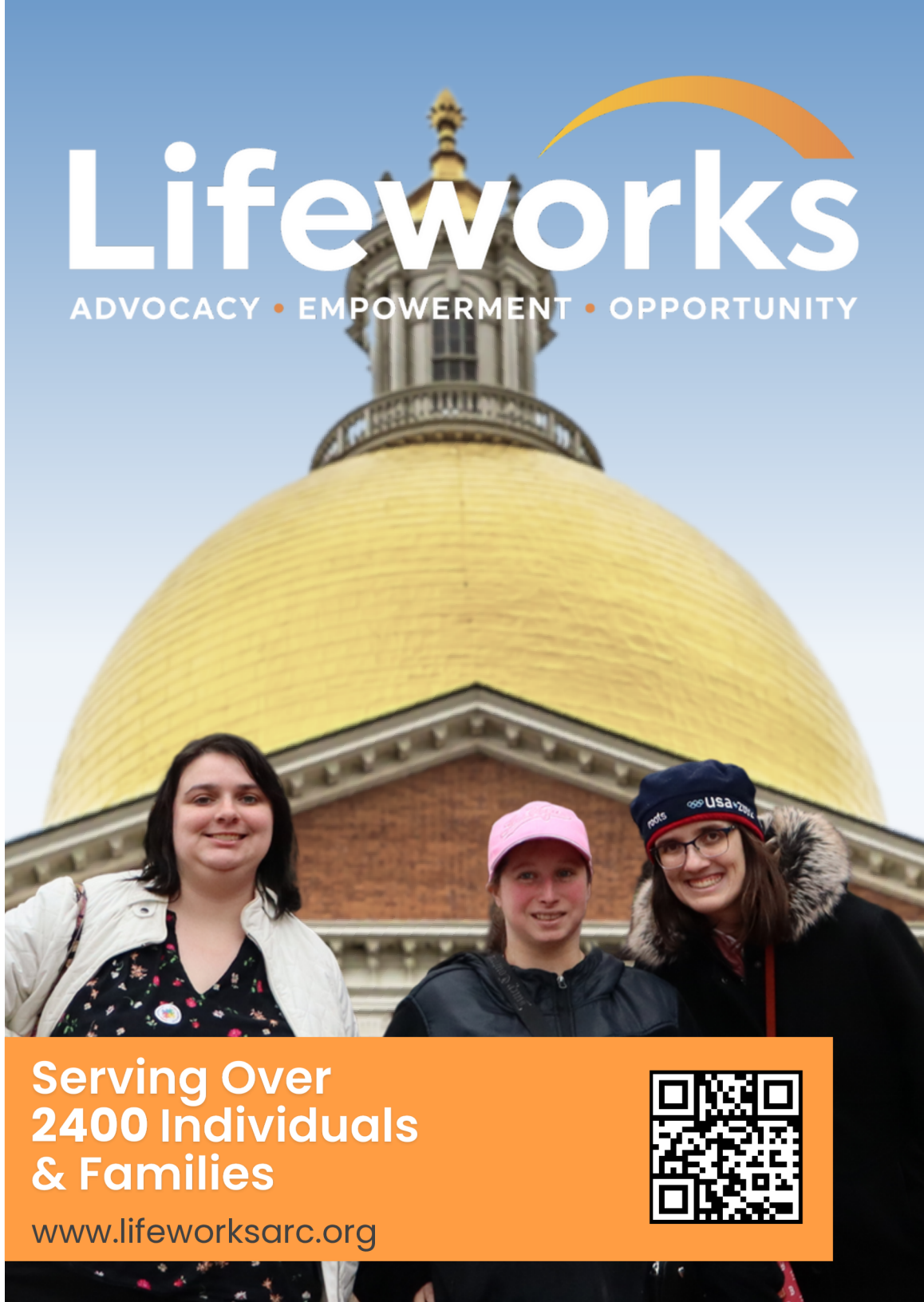

In 2025, Lifeworks is working hard to be on the front lines. We are amplifying the voices of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD), their families, and the staff who support them. From Beacon Hill to Capitol Hill, we’ve been there; we’ve spoken out; and we’ve stood shoulder to shoulder with community partners and allies to protect and expand the services that matter most.

Here’s where we’ve been so far this year:

- ADDP Legislative Budget Forum – advocating for critical program funding alongside providers from across the state.
- The Arc of Massachusetts 47th Annual Legislative Reception – sharing stories and solutions directly with lawmakers.
- Autism Advocacy Day at the State House – supporting AFAM and The Arc of MA to elevate voices in the autism community.
- Our own Legislative Breakfast, a collaborative with Charles River Center – bringing self-advocates, families, staff, and legislators together for a meaningful conversation.
- The Disability Policy Seminar in Washington, D.C. – representing Massachusetts in the nation’s capital, led by The Arc of MA.
- One-on-one meetings with legislators – ensuring decision-makers hear directly from those impacted.
- Telling our stories – sharing lived experiences drives change.

These advocacy efforts aren’t just events, they’re opportunities to shape policy and influence funding decisions; with a goal of ensuring that individuals and families we serve daily, and the staff that serve them are seen, heard, and supported.
